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On Foot

Rieger's Path – This popular route leads from the very center of Semily through the dale of the Jizera river to Podspálov, offering excellent views of the wild and rocky valley. You can use Kamenický's Path for the return journey, which, thanks to its higher location on the slope, provides vistas of the wider surroundings.

Krkavčí skála (Raven Crag) – This rugged rock formation, rising approximately 100 m above water level, provides a view of the Jizera valley from above. In addition, it is also one of seven geosites in the area with explanatory signs. More information about this can be found on the website of the Bohemian Paradise UNESCO Global Geopark.

The Slopes of Kozák – Měsíční údolí (Moon Valley), Kozákovská Drábovna (Outlaw's Hideout at Kozák), Prackov Volcano and Podzámčí Observation Point are just a few of the many destinations on the Kozák hillsides which are worth visiting, yet do not attract massive numbers of tourists.




Trips by Bike or Scooter

Masaryk Observation Point – If you don't mind climbing a hill or two, Semily's surroundings offer a whole range of picturesque views. What makes this lookout of special interest is that President Masaryk relished its panorama, and so will you.

Kozák – For cyclists who long for a challenge, the Kozák mountain is an ideal destination. As a reward for surmounting the considerable elevation difference of 425 m, using one of the multiple different routes available, you get the spectacular views from the lookout tower on the summit: in good weather, it is possible to see roughly a quarter of Bohemia. The journey downhill to Semily is an unforgettable experience in itself, especially for those on a scooter.

Bike Shuttle to the Bohemian Paradise and the Giant Mountains – In the summer holiday season, there is a shuttle bus service for cyclists providing access to Kozák, the Hrubá Skála Nature Reserve, or even Trosky Castle. If combined with train rides, picturesque journeys may reach even the environs of Malá Skála or Turnov, or allow access to the ridges of the Giant Mountains using the bike shuttle bus departing from Jilemnice.
